



The institution takes up various initiatives to motivate students to take up higher education after their graduation.

- The college conducts a orientation programme every year for the first year students which makes the students understand about the new environment of the college. As well as the college also orients about the scope of every course in terms of higher education and job opportunities.
- In addition every department organizes guest lecture and orientations by inviting experts from the respective field and also the alumni students who are pursuing higher education in other institutions to brief them about the scope of the course.
- The institution takes the students to industrial visit which makes the student understand the applicability of their course in industry and pursue higher education.
- Students from life sciences, physical sciences, management, and commerce are encouraged to take up internship, projects with industry which also gives an insight to the students the requirement of the industry and helps them in progressing further.
- The college library also provides information in the form of provided access to internet newspaper, books, periodicals, employment newspaper.
- The college offers 1 post graduate course in commerce which also makes the students to pursue further.
- About 40% of the students enroll in higher education in university, and other institution.
- The institution has mentoring system from the time of admission of the student till the completion of the course which monitors the student progression towards academic and non academic activities.
- The institution provides various career guidance counseling , certificate course program on soft skill development and various guests lectures to benefit the student academically.
- The institution has a placement cell which is handled by placement officer who ensures the placement and provides the job opportunities when student progress to fifth semester. The placement cell organizes job fairs, campus recruitment awareness.
