*E-Granthalaya* is library automation software from National Informatics Centre, Department of Electronics & Information Technology, Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, Government of India. The software has been designed by the experts for software as well as Library and Information Science discipline. Using this software the libraries can be automated for in-house activities and for user services. The software can be implemented either

in stand-alone or in client-server mode where database and Web OPAC are installed on the server PC while the data entry program is installed on client PCs. The software provides LAN/Web based data entry solutions for a cluster of libraries where a centralized/Common database can be created with Union Catalog output. The software provides Web OPAC interface to publish the library catalog over Internet/Intranet. The software runs on Windows platform Only, UNICODE Compliant, thus supports data entry in local language.
