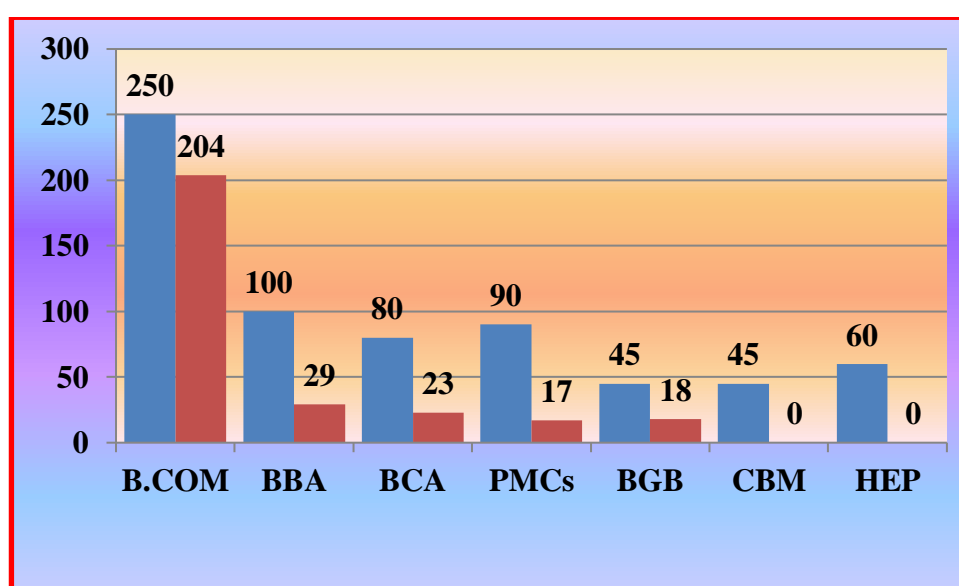
Admissions and Student Strength

The total intake of students for current academic year 2014-2015 at UG Level is 291.

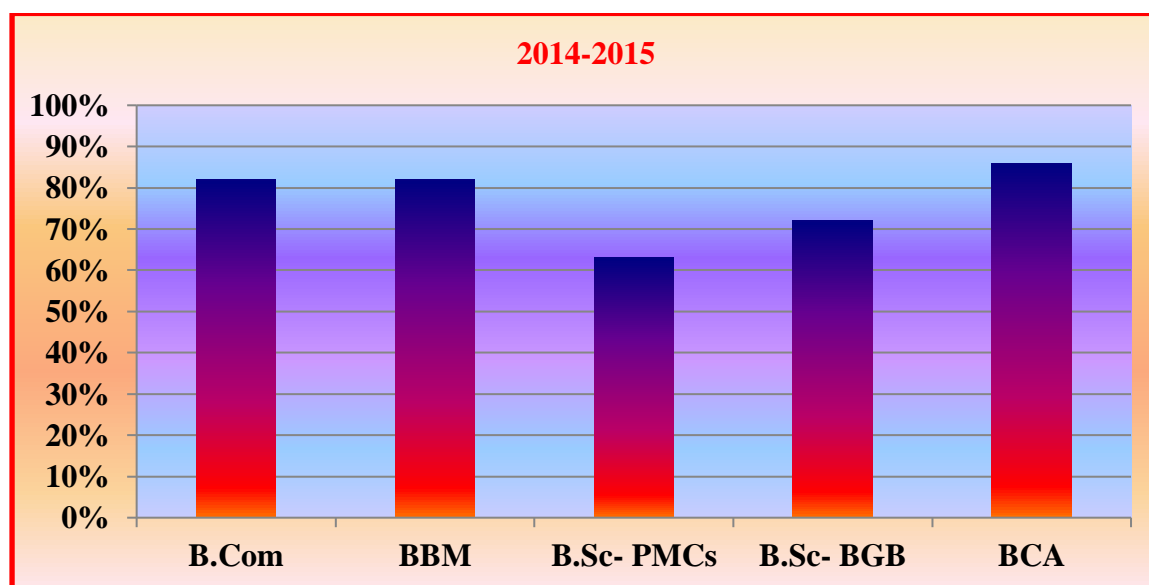
