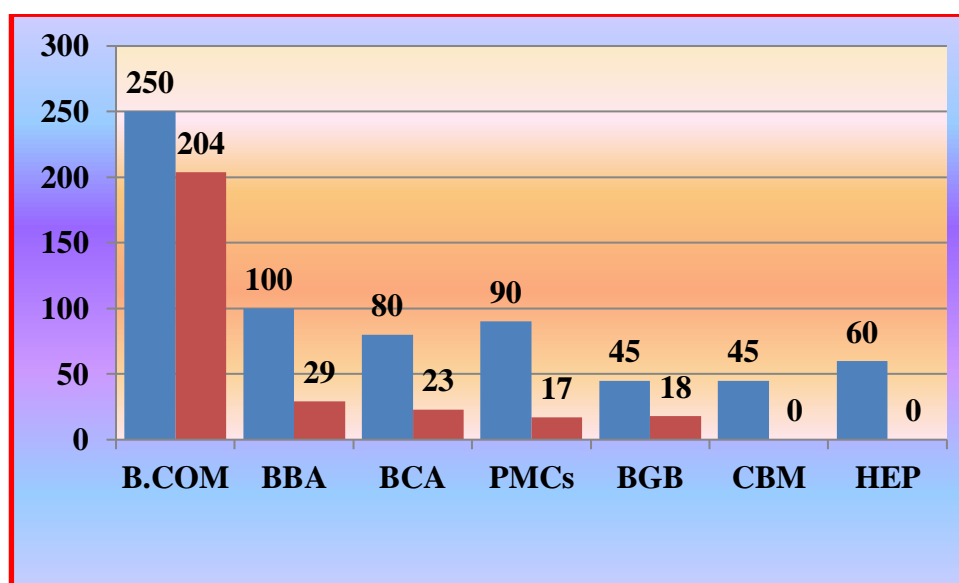
Admissions and Student Strength
